FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Carers.

At the end of last year School Association conducted a forum and a **survey** about camps for our school. Earlier this term a copy of the survey information was sent home. I hope that you had a chance to look through it and digest the outcomes. The survey was very well supported and with that kind of support it makes decision making much easier. There were four options presented and option 3 received the greatest support. With 69%.

Option 3: The "Grade 6" camp becomes a combined Grade 5/6 experience to Canberra every SECOND year. In the alternate year, there will be a trip to Hobart.

Based on this feedback there will be a combined grade 5/6 Canberra trip this year and a Hobart trip in 2020. There was a second part to the survey that asked about how much people were prepared to pay. Again the support was there for a reasonable contribution from families with 86% being prepared to pay up to \$500. To keep fundraising manageable families will be asked to contribute \$450.00. Payment plans will be offered to help families manage the cost over time. Dates are yet to be confirmed but the camp is likely to be in term 2. If you have any concerns please chat to Mr Eeles or Mrs Bennett in 5/6 or myself. More specific information will be available soon with respect to the timeline and fundraising. The cost of a trip to Canberra is substantial and even with the parent contribution a considerable amount of fundraising needs to occur. The upcoming Trivia Night is one event that will support the Grade 5/6 camp. Gather a team of friends and come along for a great night and support the cause.

Today we had the first part of our athletics featuring our Grade 3-6 students. It was great to see the students in their house colours and working hard to earn points for their house. At the end of the two days of athletic activities a representative team from Grade 3-6 will be selected to take part in the Northern Midlands Athletics Carnival that will be held on March 27th. Many thanks to the Deloraine High School Sports Leaders who came to assist and the parents that helped with the various field events. The second part of activities, including Kindergarten to Grade 2 will be held on Thursday morning.




School Levies for 2019 are now due. If you have not yet paid your levies or would like to discuss payment options, please contact Fiona Curtis, School Business Manager, on 63 93 1373 or call into

the School Office.

School levies and charges form an essential proportion of school income. As matter of equity, all parents and guardians who are not in receipt of Student Assistance Scheme (STAS) are expected to organise payment of levies. Payments can be made in full or alternatively agreeing to an ongoing payment plan over the course of the school year.

Payments may be made as follows:

•By BPAY - contact your bank or financial institution to make payment from your account (using the Biller Code and Reference detailed on your invoice):



- •At a Service Tasmania shop
- •Centrepay, a service provided through Centrelink, please ask the school for a form; or
- •At the school; we accept cash and cheques.

When using BPAY to pay school levies, please ensure that you are using the correct Reference Number, Biller Id and student Number, as this will then allow your payment to be applied correctly.

When paying two or more invoices (each invoice has a unique number) at the one time it is advisable to make separate transactions especially when part-payments are being made on more than one invoice otherwise this appears as one bulk payment which does not indicate which invoice the payment relates to.

Bullying. No Way! At Westbury Primary School





Students and teachers will be engaging in activities that support *National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence* on 15th March. This day is supported by schools Australia wide and provides an opportunity to focus on bullying and the changes we can make to create safer communities for everyone. At our school, this will involve teachers and students talking about bullying through discussions, activities and the use of resources such as videos and websites.
