If you can help provide supper, please let us know so that we can ensure we have enough on the night.



NAPLAN online 2019

NAPLAN is moving completely online in 2019. This means moving NAPLAN from paper-based assessments to online-based assessments. NAPLAN Online will provide better assessment and more precise results. The assessments feature a tailored test design where the questions a student receives will depend on their answers to previous questions.

Tasmanian schools will participate in NAPLAN Online from 2019.

NAPLAN Online testing will be held from the 14 to 24 May 2019.

NAPLAN Online 2019 will include four components, Writing, Numeracy, Conventions of Language and Reading. For 2019 Year Three students will be completing a paper based Writing Test. Online Testing will be available for each of the NAPLAN year levels (3, 5, 7 and 9)

NAPLAN Online Practice Test 2019 for Grade 3 & 5 students will provide an additional opportunity for students to become familiar with the types of questions they will encounter in NAPLAN online. The 45-minute test includes Numeracy, Conventions of Language and Reading questions, but not Writing. The focus of this test is also readiness for schools to enhance test administrators' familiarity with the assessment delivery platform, to increase confidence in test administration processes for both test administrators and students, and to ensure the ICT infrastructure within the school and classroom has sufficient capacity for the

online assessment. The NAPLAN Online Practice Test 2019 is to be held between 28

March and 11 April 2019.

Students, teachers and parents can also use the <u>Public demonstration site</u> (<u>https://www.nap.edu.au/online-assessment/public-demonstration-site</u>) to become familiar with NAPLAN Online.

LEVY PAYMENTS

School Levies for 2019 are now due. If you have not yet paid your levies or would like to discuss payment options, please contact Fiona Curtis, School Business Manager, on 63 93 1373 or call into the School Office.

School levies and charges form an essential proportion of school income. As matter of equity, all parents and guardians who are not in receipt of Student Assistance Scheme (STAS) are expected to organise payment of levies. Payments can be made in full or alternatively agreeing to an ongoing payment plan over the course of the school year.

Payments may be made as follows:

- •By BPAY contact your bank or financial institution to make payment from your account (using the Biller Code and Reference detailed on your invoice)
- •At a Service Tasmania shop
- •Centrepay, a service provided through Centrelink, please ask the school for a form; or



When using BPAY to pay school levies, please ensure that you are using the correct Reference Number, Biller Id and student Number, as this will then allow your payment to be applied correctly.

When paying two or more invoices (each invoice has a unique number) at the one time it is advisable to make separate transactions especially when part-payments are being made on more than one invoice otherwise this appears as one bulk payment which does not indicate which invoice the payment relates to.

At these meetings we hear from Ms Brown about what is happening at the school level, we plan and review fundraising events and discuss long term projects and fundraising goals.

The positions up for nomination are:

- **President:** the President provides leadership and direction for the P&F by working co-operatively and collaboratively with the Principal. Promotes the aim of the P&F in dealings with its members and supports the executive committee members.
- Vice President: the Vice-President assists the President in their role and in their absence presides over meetings and relevant duties.
- Treasurer: the Treasurer is responsible for receiving all monies, paying of P&F accounts and keeps appropriate financial records which are presented at each general meeting.
- Secretary: the Secretary manages the day-to-day communications and records of the P&F as well as organising meetings, records accurate draft minutes and then formalises them for the subsequent meeting.
- Catering Coordinator: Catering Coordinator works closely with and assists the overall committee in the organisation and execution of regular and once off catering events determined by the P&F. This may include helping in the organising of volunteers to cater for school events, BBQs, as well as regular Probus and Rotary catering.
- School Association Representative: the School Association Representative is also a current nominated member of the School Association. They work closely with both the School Association Board and the P&F Association to ensure both coordinated bodies are kept informed and up to date of the other. They will ensure the P&F Association has a voice on the SA and provide a SA report at P&F meetings.
- School Uniform Coordinator: The school uniform coordinator works closely with the Principal and Parents to provide affordable and practical School uniform to all students at WPS. They coordinate new and used uniform sales, ordering of stock and may also be involved in new school uniform design and uniform supplier contact.
- Hot Lunch Coordinator: Hot lunch coordinator may include organising a roster of volunteers to run Hot lunch at WPS and coordinating any changes throughout the term. Organising the ordering and delivery of general supplies and food, and maintaining the hot lunch menu.
