Dear Parents and Carers,

Yesterday we had a visit from **Kaboom Sports**. Kaboom Sports came as a reward for being part of the **Move Well Eat Well** Program. Wednesday 3rd – after school from 3pm-7pm


Thursday 4th - Lunch time




Dear Parent/Caregiver,

INGREDIENTS

1 pumpkin (cut into pieces)

Onion-diced

1small potato(diced)

1carrot (diced)

Celery (1small stick)

Curry powder- 1-2teaspoons

ıteaspoon veg stock powder

ıteaspoon chicken stock powder

2 chicken stock cubes

Water

Butter for frying

METHOD

Fry onions, butter and curry powder with half the pumpkin, then add rest of pumpkin, potato, carrot, celery, stock powder and stock cubes .

Add water just to cover bring to boil then let simmer till vegeta-

bles are soft .

Blend and then serve.
