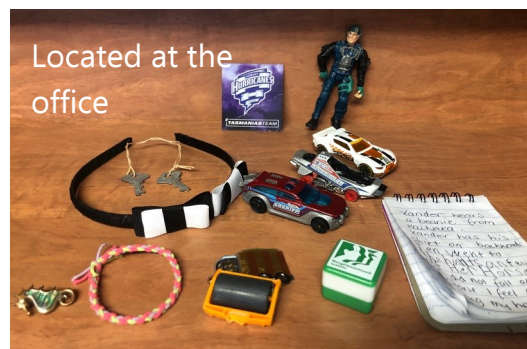
LOST & FOUND

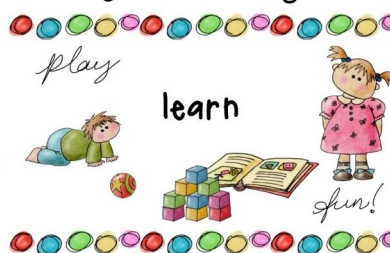


