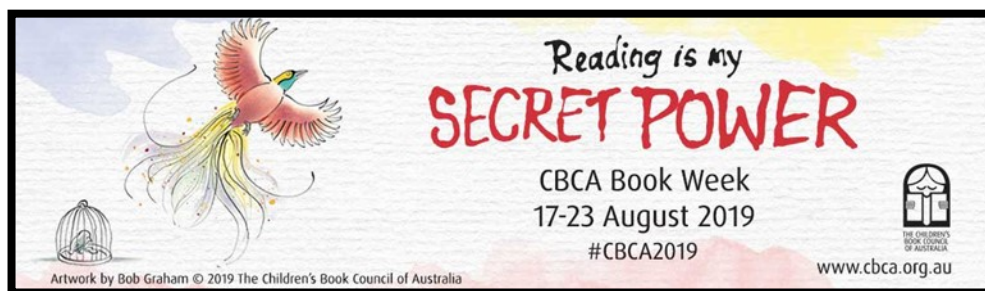

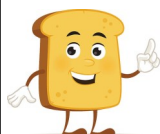
There is no cost.
