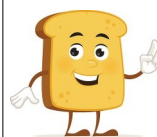

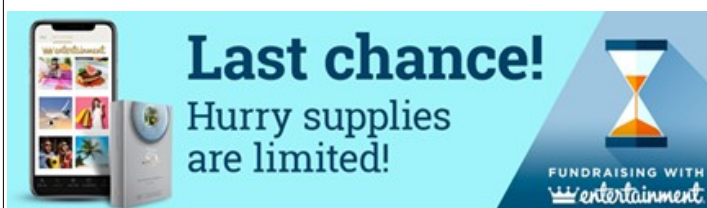

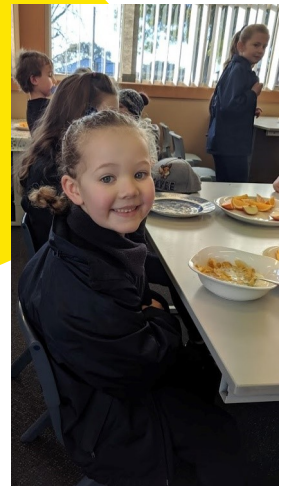

### Zones of Regulation in 1/2

Each day after lunch Grade 1/2 come in from the lunch break a find their Zones of Regulation wheel. This wheel is divided in four zones to represent each of the Zones of Regulation with colours that correspond to the zones colours. A selection of children are chosen to share their perspective of which zone they were in for most of the lunch time. The green zone is the most desirable zone to be in. Children might suggest they were there because they were having fun playing with friends, enjoyed being in the library or found a way to help a friend. Some will be in the blue zone, perhaps explaining that they were tired or they were feeling lonely as they could not find anyone to play with. Occasionally a child might have a time in the yellow zone, where they might have fallen and hurt themselves or they might be feeling frustrated about someone else's response to something they have said or done. It is great to note that usually we only have two or three children wanting to show that they have been in the yellow zone and then it is often along with a time in the green zone as well. It is fantastic that there has not been an occasion of a child in the red zone, where they would be feeling very angry or very upset due to something that had happen. This suggests that the children in Grade 1/2 are having lots of very positive lunch time experiences. Mrs Tyeson

### Chunky Vegetable Soup

Butter  
2 medium onions, chopped  
2 medium carrots, chopped  
2 sticks of celery  
1 medium potato, chopped  
2 medium zucchini, sliced  
1/2 a cabbage, shredded  
1/2 a small pumpkin, chopped  
1 litre of vegetable stock  
liquid  
425g. Tomatoes undrained  
crushed  
1 tin of corn  
1 cup beans

Melt butter and fry onions until tender,  
Add carrots, celery and potatoes, cook stirring  
for 5 minutes  
Stir in zucchini, cabbage, pumpkin, stock,  
tomatoes, beans and corn  
Simmer, cover about 1 1/2 hours or until soup  
is thickened  
When cooked serve.

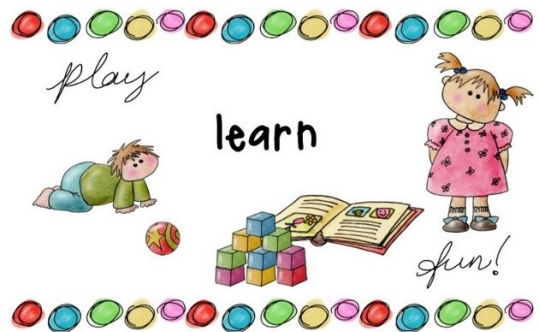
