FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Carers,

There will be a number of staffing changes for the start of term 3. Several of them are as a result of me taking three weeks long service leave at the beginning of term 3. While I am away, Michelle Murphie will be acting Principal. Mrs Murphie's AST role will be filled by Mrs Karen Walker. The Prep/1 class will have Mrs Sarah Davies as their teacher. Mrs Davies worked in Kindergarten with Mrs Mead two years ago.

Mrs Kim Tyeson is taking some leave to have an operation on her foot. Grade 1/2 will have Mrs Kerry Anne Buckby as their teacher until Mrs Tyeson's return. Mrs Buckby worked in the school at the start of the year and taught Mrs Tyeson's class for several weeks last year. Mrs Buckby will be in the class on Friday this week and will meet with Mrs Tyeson to prepare for term 3.

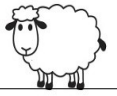

Cauliflower and Cheese Soup

INGREDIENTS

2 tablespoons olive oil
1 large onion, peeled and chopped
2 garlic cloves, chopped
1 potato, chopped
1 large cauliflower, cut into florets
300 ml chicken stock
300 ml milk
salt & pepper
Cheese

METHOD

Using a deep saucepan, heat 2 tablespoons of olive oil, add chopped onion
cook until soft, but not brown about 5mins.
Add chopped garlic cloves.
Place the cauliflower and chopped potato into the saucepan, followed by
chicken stock and milk and bring to the boil.
Cover the soup and simmer for 15-20 minutes, or until the cauliflower is soft.
Puree the mixture
Season to taste with salt & pepper and add a sprinkling of grated cheese. Serve
it warm with crusty bread.

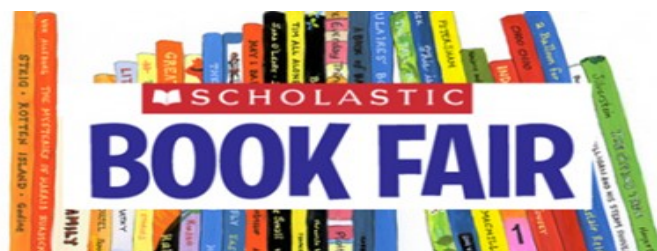
