FROM THE PRINCIPAL

DEAR PARENTS AND CARERS,

It is the time of year when we seek feedback from staff, parents and students through the **Annual School Satisfaction Surveys**. These are Department of Education surveys and are conducted across all schools. The surveys provide an opportunity for parents and staff to give important feedback on what the school does well and where we can improve. Questions cover a range of topics about our school. All responses are secure and anonymous.

All **parents** will receive a unique letter with information about how to complete the survey. The survey is open from August 19th until September 13th. Surveys can be done online or on paper (copies available from the office). To complete the survey online you need to use the unique code on the letter that you receive. Every response counts. Please contact the office if you wish to use a school computer to complete the survey.

This year **student surveys** will look very different to those used in the past. The wellbeing of our students is important to us. All students from Grade 4 - 6 will be taking part in the survey. The Student Wellbeing Survey is part of the [Department of Education's Child and Student Wellbeing Strategy](#). The survey will be undertaken in class time and you do not need to do anything to prepare your child.

Tomorrow is one of the most exciting days of the year. It is **Book Week Parade Day**. Students can come to school dressed as one of their favourite book characters. We encourage characters from books and would prefer that superheroes stayed home. Students from Grade 5/6 who dress in a book week character will need to ensure that they have their school uniform to change into to travel to Deloraine High School.






STUDENT ATTENDANCE

With Qkr you can:

- Pay for school fees, uniforms, excursions and more;
- See your receipts on the app and get them sent by email if required.


Step 1 Download Qkr!

Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10km's of the school, or search for our school by name.

Step 4 Register your children
When first accessing our school you will be prompted to add a student profile for your child. This allows you to make orders and payments for them.
