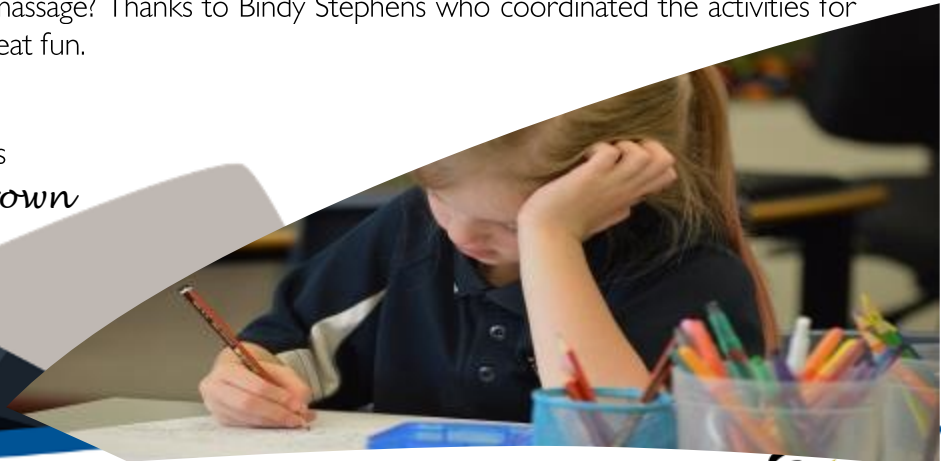

## THE ZONES OF REGULATION



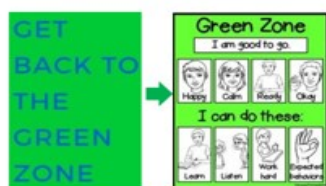

## THE ZONES OF REGULATION



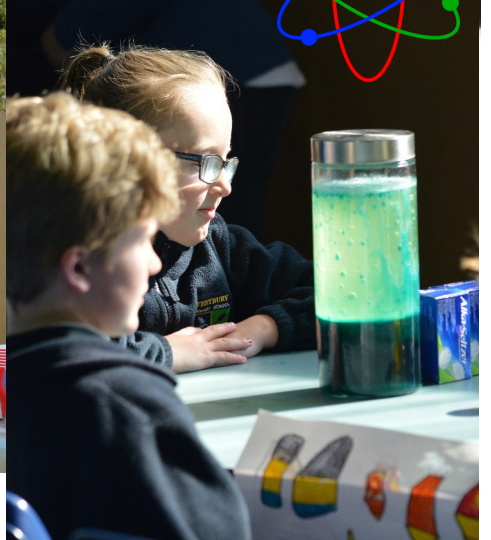
*This is a space that helps me regulate my feelings so I can get back into the green zone and continue with my learning.*
