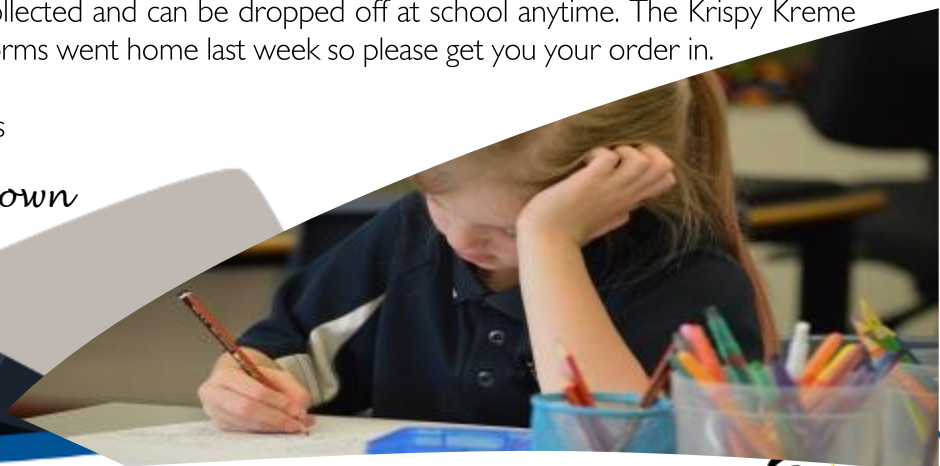

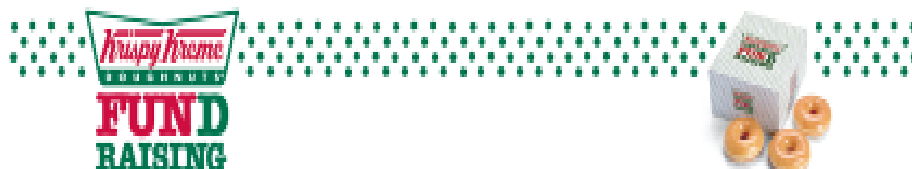

An order/collection sheet has been sent home with students today and copies are available from the office.

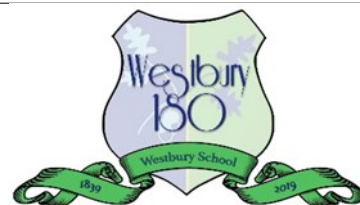
**All orders and money must be received by the end of term, Friday 27<sup>th</sup> of September.**

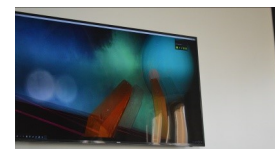
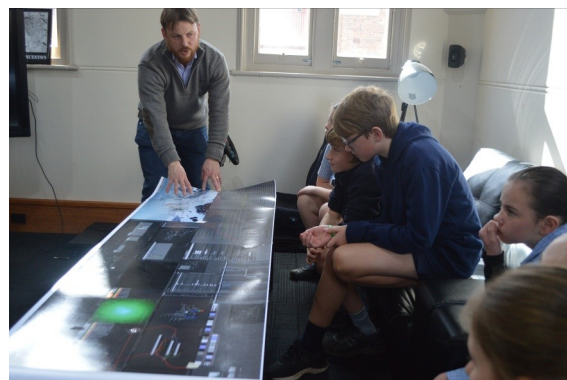
